SWFSC Rimfire Match

Course of Fire:

Matches will be held on the first Friday of each month. If a cancelation is necessary, we will try to reschedule if there are open dates available.

All shooting positions will be on a **first come basis**, shooters can shoot prone or bench, it will be their choice. When there are more shooters then positions, a second relay will be added.

50 Yard Target

5 minutes for prep time.

30 minutes total, will be allotted for sighters and 50 rounds for score

100 Yard Target

5 minutes prep time.

20 minutes total time for sighters and 20 rounds for score.

Total possible score for match is 700. X's will be counted only on the 100 yard targets.

Classes:

SWFSC rimfire match shall be divided into 2 Classes, Factory Sporter and Unlimited.

Factory Sporter Class

Rifles:

Any magazine or tube fed, or single fed rifle in production that is readily available and produced in quantities greater than 500 with MSRP of LESS than \$1200.00.

Barrel should have the manufacturer's name and logo stamped into the barrel.

Ammunition does not need to be fed from the magazine. Competitors may load the ammunition one round at a time.

Any optic is allowable and may be attached to the rifle as originally designed by the manufacturer.

No modifications to the firearm or stock are permitted except as outlined below.

Trigger mechanism may be modified or replaced completely but must at all times function safely.

Re-crowning of barrel is permitted.

Bipods are permitted and may be attached to the stock. Rails may be added to the stock solely for the purpose of attaching a bipod.

The rifle may be glass and pillar bedded to the stock; but, must be removable from the stock. Only modifications for inletting are allowed to the stock.

The butt of the stock may be shortened or lengthened to adjust for Length of Pull. The swivel studs may be removed.

No other modifications to the rifle are allowed, including but not limited to re- chambering barrel, adding weight to stock, adding attachments to the barrel such as a tuner or adding plates to the forearm of the stock.

Rests:

One-Piece rests are strictly prohibited in factory sporter class.

Two-Piece rests are allowed. The front and rear rest may not be attached in any manner.

Bipods are allowed.

Unlimited Class

Rifles:

Any firearm chambered for the .22 Long Rifle cartridge may be used.

Rifles that the buyer has the option to pick the stock, trigger action, and barrel will be considered **Unlimited Class**

There are no weight limits, no classes, and no dimensional restrictions to barrels, stocks, or limits on scope magnification.

Any Factory Sporter rifle may be shot in the unlimited class if desired.

Rests:

Any rest may be used to shoot from the bench, or prone, so long as any such rest prevents the barreled action from being affixed to the bench in an immovable manner.
