

NRA Registered 300 Yard F-Class Match

Date, Time and Cost

This match is held monthly from November through May on the first Sunday of the month. Check the club calendar for match dates.

We recommend that you arrive as early as possible to ensure a shooting spot.

Registration and setup is at 8:00 am and the match starts promptly at 9:00 am, Bay 3.

Fee is \$20 for club members and \$25 for non-club members*. SWFSA maintains a locked gate policy. Non members need to contact the match director for information.

The high aggregate shooter in each category is awarded a medal.

Match Rules

The course of fire:

The match is governed by **NRA High Power rules**. Click [here](#) to download the rules

The match is shot in the prone position (belly rest on the ground) and there are three 20 minute courses of fire of 20 rounds each for record. A 10 minute period is provided for unlimited sighters prior to the first course of fire.

There are two categories in the match: F-Open and F/TR.

The **F-Open category** includes any caliber up to .35 and may be shot using a front and rear rest, not connected, and a scope. Overall rifle weight cannot exceed 22.05 pounds.

The **F/TR category** is restricted to either .223 or .308 caliber, using front and rear rests, not connected, and a scope. Total weight, including bipod and scope, cannot exceed 18.18 pounds.

These are NRA Registered matches and are governed by the NRA High Power rules (<http://rulebooks.nra.org/documents/pdf/compete/RuleBooks/HPR/hpr-book.pdf>).
