Additional Information about Saturday Challenge

The Saturday Challenge is now more than just a handgun challenge. We currently have 8 separate divisions for handguns, rifles and shotguns. They consist of Single Stack, Double Stack, Revolver, Rimfire pistol, Hi power rifle, Rimfire rifle, Semi auto shotgun and Pump shotgun.

To compete, the shooter needs eye/ear protection, a gun and holster, multiple magazines with a way to carry them and ammo. It's common (but not required) for a shooter to shoot multiple guns and run through the course 3 or 4 times so, bring lots of ammo.

A shooting course or stage, is setup in Bay 1 and consists of approximately 30 rounds for the handgun or rifle. The shotgun is normally half of that at 15 rounds. The shooting stage is designed to be challenging and may require multiple shots per target. The shooter may need to move around walls and barriers to shoot all the targets. The shooting stage is different at each Handgun Challenge so it never gets boring.

We frequently run different match formats including BUG gun matches, IDPA style formats, a Carry Gun format and a Glock Shooting Sports format. In addition we run a side match, usually on the first Saturday of the month. These matches are a short single stage and offer challenges not usually found in the regular match format.

The current cost is \$3 per gun. FREE your first time. The match set up starts at 9:00am. As soon as the set up is complete, we start shooting.
