

Saturday Challenge RULES OF THE GAME

(Revision 2, 11/15/16)

THIS IS A COLD RANGE. ALL FIREARMS WILL BE UNLOADED AT ALL TIMES EXCEPT ON THE LINE.

NO OPEN HANDLING OF FIREARMS IN THE PARKING LOT IS PERMITTED. VIOLATORS WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO PARTICIPATE IN THE MATCH

FIREARMS ARE HANDLED ONLY AT THE SAFETY TABLE OR AT THE LINE ON ORDER OF THE SO.

FIREARMS WILL BE CARRIED EMPTY WITH NO MAGAZINE & HOLSTERED, OR BAGGED AND UNLOADED.

ALL FIREARMS ARE CARRIED EMPTY WITH HAMMERS DOWN.

STRIKER FIRED PISTOLS ARE CARRIED WITH THE STRIKER UNCOCKED.

DE-COCKING PISTOLS ARE CARRIED WITH THE HAMMER DOWN, NOT IN THE DE-COCKED POSITION.

WHEN LOADED AT THE LINE, ALL APPLICABLE SAFETIES MUST BE ON, HAMMERS DE-COCKED, ETC.

Classes:

- ✓ Single Stack: Any pistol limited to 8 rounds in the magazine max.
- ✓ Double Stack: Any pistol limited to 18 rounds in the magazine max.
- ✓ Open: Pistols with over 18 rounds in the magazine and/or optic sights, any race gun options (extended mag wells, compensators, ** ported barrels, etc.) **and/or completion focused clothing such as cleated footwear, shooting gloves, etc. *A basic guideline: Ask yourself if you would carry your firearm concealed in this condition or would you wear this around the house or on the street as part of your regular wardrobe. **Added 11/16*
- ✓ Revolver: Any revolvers, no limit on cylinder capacity.
- ✓ Rimfire: Any pistol chambered for rimfire cartridges
- ✓ Rimfire Rifles (any magazine capacity but 1 reload required)
- ✓ High Power Rifles (any center fire cartridge, any magazine capacity, 1 reload required)
- ✓ Pump Shotguns (8 rounds in the magazine + 1 in the chamber max)
- ✓ Auto Shotguns (8 rounds in the magazine + 1 in the chamber max)

Keep the muzzle pointed downrange at the berm whenever possible

Do not break the 180° line with the muzzle. Any infractions will result in an immediate disqualification.

Keep your finger off the trigger when moving or reloading.

Do not handle your firearm except when called to the line or when at the safety table.

Pistols must be holstered or bagged unless at the line or the safety table. *Fanny packs, cross-draw and small of back holsters are not permitted. * Added 9/16

Long guns must have** an ECI visible. **Deleted "be in the rack with", replaced with "have" 11/16

Breaking the 180 is an immediate DQ.

Sweeping yourself or another with a firearm (empty or not) is an immediate DQ.

Accidental discharges are an immediate DQ (subject to review by the MD and/or SO).
