

Saturday Challenge First Time Instructions

- This is a COLD range; all firearms must be unloaded at all times except at the firing line.
- All firearms must be empty and bagged/cased on arrival at the range.
- Absolutely no handling of firearms except at the safety table, rifle rack or on the firing line.
**NO OPEN HANDLING OF FIREARMS IN THE PARKING LOT IS PERMITTED.
VIOLATORS WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO PARTICIPATE IN THE MATCH**
- When at the safety table or gun rack **KEEP THE MUZZLE POINTED AT THE BERM.**
- Firearms should be un-bagged, verified empty, made safe and holstered or re-bagged at the safety table. Holstered or bagged firearms must be in a safe condition.
 - Single action – Hammer down
 - Double action – Hammer down (not just de-cocked)
 - Safe action – Striker de-cocked
- **Fanny packs, cross-draw or small of the back holsters are not permitted. *Added 9/16***
- Long guns may be un-bagged at the rifle rack, or under RSO supervision. **KEEP THE MUZZLE POINTED IN A SAFE DIRECTION.** Verify empty and place muzzle up with a flag in the action. Return the firearm to the rack after completion of the course of fire with the flag in the action.
- Always keep the muzzle pointed downrange on the line.
- Always keep your finger off the trigger until ready to fire, especially when moving and/or changing magazines during the course of fire.
- Watch your muzzle direction when moving:
KEEP IT POINTED AT THE BERM NOT AT THE SKY OR THE GROUND
- Always obey the commands of the Range Safety Officer (RSO).
- The 180° rule is in effect on the range. Violations will result in disqualification.
- Be attentive to gun handling! Dropping a loaded firearm will result in disqualification.
- Mark your brass and it will be returned. Unmarked brass and left-behind brass will be split up after tear-down amongst the remaining shooters.
