SWFSA Construction Status as of 02-19-2020

New Pond:

Dug to depth. A lot of rock removed. Rock is piled along or near the new berms.

Because the bottom of the pond is deeper than the ground water table, a pump had to run continuously while the pond was being dug. Digging required a heavy-duty pneumatic hammer to break up the rock.

Lots of rock is piled there.
