THIS IS A COLD RANGE. ALL FIREARMS WILL BE UNLOADED AT ALL TIMES EXCEPT ON THE LINE.

NO OPEN HANDLING OF FIREARMS IN THE PARKING LOT IS PERMITTED. VIOLATORS WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO PARTICIPATE IN THE MATCH

ON ARRIVAL PLEASE TAKE YOUR CASED FIREARM TO THE SAFETY TABLE.

AT THE TABLE:

- 1. VERIFY IT IS UNLOADED
- 2. OPEN THE ACTION AND INSERT AN ECI (EMPTY CHAMBER INDICATOR). Contact the Match Director if you need one.
- 3. PUT THE SAFETY ON AND RE-CASE THE FIREARM.
- 4. MOVE THE CASED FIREARM WITH THE REST OF YOUR GEAR TO THE FIRING LINE TABLES.

Classes:

Rimfire Rifles **NOTE**:

Centerfire Rifles MUZZLE BRAKE TYPE DEVICES WILL
Pistol Caliber Carbines NEED A BLAST FORWARDING DEVICE

Each class has three categories
Open Sights
Telescopic Sights
Receiver Mounted Sights (Dot, Laser, etc.)

When called to the line for the first time bring your cased firearm to the shooting position and make ready at the instructions of the RSO (Range Safety Officer).

When finished clear and stow your firearm at the instructions of the RSO with:

- 1. THE ACTION OPEN
- 2. ON SAFE
- 3. ECI PLACED IN THE MAGAZINE WELL OR IN THE ACTION AS PRACTICAL. IT IS NOT NECESSARY TO INSERT THE ECI INTO THE CHAMBER OF THE RIFLE.

When called to the line for subsequent stages retrieve your rifle at the instruction of the RSO.

Keep your finger off the trigger when moving or reloading.

Do not handle your firearm except when called to the line or when at the safety table.

Do not break the 180° line with the muzzle. Any infractions will result in a disqualification.

Sweeping yourself or another with a firearm (empty or not) will result in a disqualification.

Accidental discharges will result in a disqualification.

All actions above are subject to by the Range Officer and/or Match Director.
