

Vintage Military Rifle Match

\$5.00 Match Fee. First time shooters no charge. **PLEASE SIGN UP WHEN YOU ARRIVE.**

Open to all centerfire military rifles issued before 1948.

All others are welcome but will shoot as unclassified.

Three Classes:

B – Bolt action or manually operated rifles

S – Semi-automatic rifles

U – Unclassified (issued after 1948 or with optical sights)

Set up at 8:30, shooting starts at 9:00 AM.

The match is held on the 5th Saturdays of the month as they fall. Check the club calendar.

COURSE OF FIRE

5 Sighting Shots (5 rounds in 5 minutes, additional shots permitted).

10 Rounds Prone Slow Fire (10 rounds in 10 minutes).

10 Rounds Prone Rapid Fire (2 strings of 5 rounds, 40 seconds each).

10 Rounds Standing (10 rounds in 10 minutes)

EQUIPMENT

Rifle w/ 2 magazines, clips or stripper clips

Minimum of 35 rounds of ammunition.

Eye and Ear Protection.

Staple Gun for posting targets

Pen, pencil or crayon

OPTIONAL

Issue sling (no cuff type, padded or lined slings). Slings permitted for Sighting and Prone strings, not permitted during Standing.

Shooting or Work Glove

Shooting Jacket

Spotting Scope

Shooting Mat (the club has a limited supply, please bring one if available)

THE CLUB WILL SUPPLY TARGETS, STICKS AND CARDBOARD BACKING.
